

The Toledo Municipal Court supports Ohio Department of Health Director's Stay at Home Order issued March 22, 2020 with significant restrictions on operations. The Toledo Municipal Court has limited hearings to only those cases where the defendant is in jail. On any individual case, a prosecutor, defendant, defense counsel or alleged victim may petition the Court electronically to have a hearing go forward regardless of whether the defendant is currently in jail. Victims or witnesses with questions about felony cases should contact the County Prosecutor's Office at (419)213-4700. During the COVID-19 pandemic, entry into the building is limited to the attorney, victim or subpoenaed witness or by appointment. For questions about building entry, please call (419) 245-1949. Court Deputies will enforce social distancing protocols and any individual who is ill will not be permitted into the building.

These further restrictions allow Toledo Municipal Court to protect the public health while maintaining the Court's essential functions.
